## INSTALLING 'NAPA' on a PC running WINDOWS 64 bits. (Windows 10 or 11)

## > Choose the disk where you will place and run NAPA.

\*\*\*\* Step 1 \*\*\*\*

Unzip 'Simulate.zip' with 7-ZIP, using the password you have received.
Unzipped directory 'Simulate' MUST be moved as '\Simulate' on the root of the disk.

\*\*\*\* Step 2 \*\*\*\*

In '.\Simulate\InstallDos', launch 'INSTALL.bat' to install the NAPA environment and to create the shortcuts 'Napa Vineyard' and 'Napa Vineyard – Mini' on the desktop of your computer.

- >>> Your PC will be possibly automatically restarted. In this case, you will have
- >>> to launch again 'INSTALL.bat' to complete the installation.

\*\*\*\* Step 3 \*\*\*\*

Click to the icon 'Napa Vineyard' or 'Napa Vineyard – Mini' on the desktop. It is then preferable, although not mandatory, to change the appearance by choosing 'medium icons' or 'large icons'.

\*\*\*\* Step 4 \*\*\*\* -- TEST --

Click on 'Editor Crimson for Napa'.

Open file '\Simulate\InstallDos\TEST\test.nap'.

Press 'Alt R' to start a simulation. The simulator NAPA should run.

You will receive then some instructions to produce a first plot.

\*\*\*\* Step 5 \*\*\*\*

It is time to read the file '\Simulate\NapaDos\Doc\NAPA TEASER.pdf'.

It can be accesses from the 'Napa Vineyard' panel.

\*\*\*\* Step 6 \*\*\*\*
